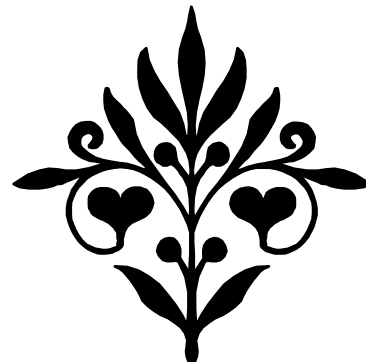

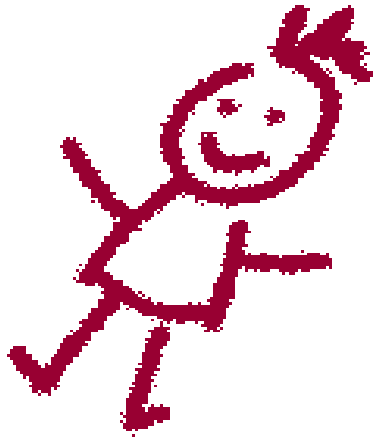

## Looking for something to do with the family?

We'll check out a few local programs that might just interest you.

Did you know that Santa Ana College boasts the largest planetarium in Orange County? The Tessman Planetarium offers a variety of programs that might interest your family if you enjoy exploring the mysteries of the Universe. For reservations and more information call the Tessman Planetarium at 714-564-6356 on Tuesday and Thursday between 10 A.M. and 1 P.M. Ask about their programs and which ones are appropriate for your child.

The Fullerton Arboretum located at 1900 Associated Rd. on the northeast corner of California State University, Fullerton offers programs for Junior Gardener's ages 6-9 and 10-13. There is a small fee for these programs. Call (714) 278-3579 for further information. They also have workshops, lectures and will answer any gardening questions that you might have.

The Kidseum is a hands-on multi-cultural art museum for children of all ages and their families. Located at the corner of 18<sup>th</sup> and Main Streets in Santa Ana, this museum offers a wide variety of programs and activities. Join them

on Wednesdays from 10 A.M.-11 A.M. for Pre-School Discoveries geared for children under the age of five. This class offers interactive stories, music and art. Call (714) 480-1523 to make a reservation. On Saturday and Sunday from 1:30 P.M.-2:30 P.M. The South Coast Storytellers Guild weaves folktales, myths and stories from around the world. There is an Art Lab, offered every 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of the month and they have Tea Parties. For more information call 714-480-1520.

Discovery Science Center offers Tiny Wonders Storytime for children ages 3-6 years old. Join the fun every Wednesday and Thursday afternoon from 2:30 P.M.-3:30 P.M. Create a project based on the weekly theme and learn about science. This program is free with the cost of admission, no reservation required. If you are an educator and would like to learn about workshops and field trips, plan to attend an Educator's Open House offered every first Monday of the month. The Santa Ana Zoo offers a variety of natural science workshops to the public on weekdays and Saturdays. Some of the programs include Mommy and Me, Breakfast with the Beasts, Animal Handling and Roar and Snore. All classes require advance registration. For dates and times, contact the Education Department at 714-836-4000.

For those of you who teach your children at home and would like to add more activities to your present curriculum contact the Education Departments of these organizations and ask about classes and workshops. You don't have to be a certified teacher for many of these programs. Fees for classes vary, so be sure to ask when you call.
